Pastor Scott not only edifies the body during Sunday and Wednesday's church services, but also spends his Thursdays teaching us chapter by chapter, verse by verse in the book of Acts. It is a fascinating historical book that sets the example to us blood washed saints to go out into the world and fulfill the Great Commission that our Lord Jesus Christ states in Matthew 28:19-20 and Mark 16:15.

Acts is divided into two parts: the first part focuses on the Jews, while the second focuses on the Gentiles. This transitional book tells the story of the early church starting with the Day of Pentecost and provides us with truth concerning the trials and persecutions those Christians went through. Throughout the class, we have had open-forum discussions as well as hard questions, and in each case we were all challenged and exhorted to study deeper into the Scriptures to find the answers.

It has been a true blessing in my life considering that I am currently young and desire to be fed spiritually so that I too may "teach others also." I would definitely recommend Thursday night Bible Institute to anyone who would like to learn more about the Word as well as to be challenged and sharpened by other students. We are a nice bunch and you can expect a laid-back atmosphere (plus a few cookies from students who have either missed class or showed up late).
