1 Timothy 6:13

The single greatest motivating factor in person's life-- view of God.

A person's lifestyle reflects what believes about God.

J.B.Phillips reason Christians ineffective-- *Your God is Too Small*

A.W.Tozer *What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us ...The history of mankind will probably show that no people has ever risen above its religion, and man's spiritual history will positively demonstrate that no religion has ever been greater than its idea of God.... For this reason the gravest question before the Church is always God Himself, and the most portentous fact about any man is not what he at a given time may say or do, but what he in his deep heart conceives God to be like.... Were we able to extract from any man a complete answer to the question, "What comes into your mind when you think about God?" we might predict with certainty the spiritual future of that man. (Tozer, 9)*

Timothy in great need of encouragement.

Six attributes of God.

1. Great Giver of Life

1 Timothy 6:13

Quickeneth all things: give life; make alive, spiritual power to arouse and invigorate; to preserve life.

When God involved, there is life.

who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession; John 18:36-37.

Jesus tells Pilate He is king and Messiah...His kingdom is represented by truth. Jesus knew this confession result in crucifixion

Jesus didn't back off ... He was committed to watchful eye of God, the Father, ... raises from the dead (Col 2:12).

Keep presenting truth, Timothy.

Representing God of universe.

Mac: Understanding God's power to raise the dead allows the man of God to freely give away his life in sacrificial service. Luke 9:24.... Viewing his ministry in that light frees the man of God to pursue it fearlessly to the utmost.

who quickeneth all things, Gives life to, sustains, preserves life

First: In beginning God gave life to universe.

Created all things.

Genesis 1:1 Eccl 12:1; Isa 40:28; 43:15; Rom 1:25; 1 Pet 4:19

Second, From beginning God sustains life.

Keeps things alive at will.

Nehemiah 9:6 Acts 17:28

Third: God guards His family.

Child of God cannot die until God says "Come home."

Fourth: God gives eternal life.

Timothy, These men can threaten you,plot to take life but remember – at moment of death ushered into presence of God.

2. Great Conqueror. God is invincible. Unbeatable. Unconquerable. Never subdued.

1 Timothy 6:14-15

Keep this commandment: things Paul told Timothy

A. What to do: Keep commandment. Flee, follow, fight.

B. How do it: without spot, unrebukeable

C. How long: until Jesus comes

A . What to do. **14 That thou keep this commandment**

Flee, Follow, fight.

B. How do it. *without spot, unrebukeable*

Without spot: unsullied, unblemished. Obey Word,

Unrebukeable: no occasion for reproach or reproof; irreproachable
Philippians 2:15

C. How long? *until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:*

Appearing: when Jesus shows up, makes His appearance.

Until Jesus visibly and gloriously comes down to earth to judge and set up His kingdom.

All history come to end.

Christ vindicated ...all who are His.

1 Timothy 6:15

Blessed: happy, content, fulfilled.

In God there is no unhappiness, discontent, or worry. Always fulfilled.

God always satisfied and at peace.

Always perfectly joyful.

Nothing changes supernatural contentment.

In control of everything

As I grow in my personal relationship with God I enter into this blessedness.

the King of kings, and Lord of lords; above all. The only God.

1 Timothy 6:16

... Who only hath immortality

Immortality: deathless.

Life never ends ... incapable of dying.

Beyond all history and time.

6. One who is Holy

...dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto

Preeminent and supreme.

Transcendent.

Out of our range

Inaccessible

Mac: *He lives in an atmosphere of absolute purity, far too holy for mortals to ever enter.*

Martin Luther. *He is the hidden God.*

Mac: *Had He not revealed Himself and come out of His holy habitation, man could have had no knowledge of Him.*
