## Youth Ministry

**Vacation Bible School** is not simply the children's activity that is scheduled for the hottest 5 nights of every year. It is much more than that. "VBS" is a vital part of the outreach and discipleship at Woodside Baptist Church! Sure it involves some sacrifice on our parts, but I believe that Vacation Bible School is a ministry that has *so much more potential* than we give it every year.

**When is VBS? Coming sooner than you think! June 15-19th (Monday - Friday) 6:15-8:30pm.**

**Let me share the 3 main purposes for the VBS**

**ministry:**

- 1. To Evangelize** - we can reach the lost children in our neighborhoods and community. These young people are at such a ripe time in their lives. If we fail to capture them for Christ now, they are doomed to be dragged into Satan's trap of worldliness, sin, and humanism. Because many families who are unsaved send their children to VBS, this is also a good way to reach whole families!
- 2. To Disciple** the young people of our church. The teaching and activities of VBS are meant not only to help unsaved children, but to show the children of our church that the Bible truly is the exciting adventure that we say it is.
- 3. To Equip** the people of our church to serve. We are always talking about service, and this is a great opportunity to serve! We are constantly taking in Biblical knowledge, *but if we do nothing with that knowledge, it simply lays stagnant in our lives. VBS gives us the opportunity to take what we have learned and apply it in service.*

**What can you do to help the VBS ministry of Woodside Baptist Church?**

- 1. Pray** - Pray for the preparation and program. *Also, pray specifically about how the Lord might want you to play a part.*
- 2. Serve** - The VBS program runs purely on the *volunteer service* of the people of Woodside. Think about how your talents could best be used, and use them for the Lord!
- 3. Support** - Prayer and Service are both key ways to support the ministry. Another way in which you can help support VBS is by *financially supporting* the program or donating food and materials.
